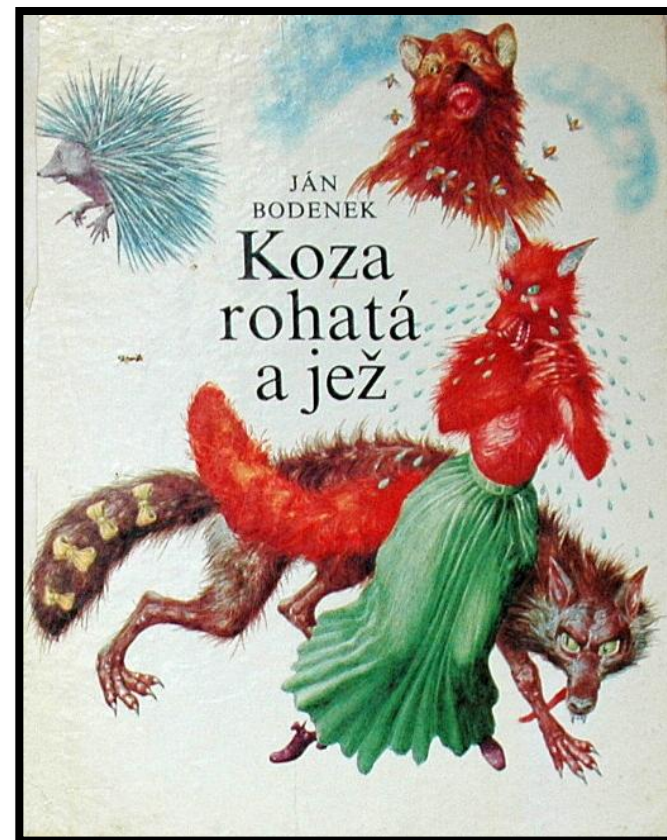
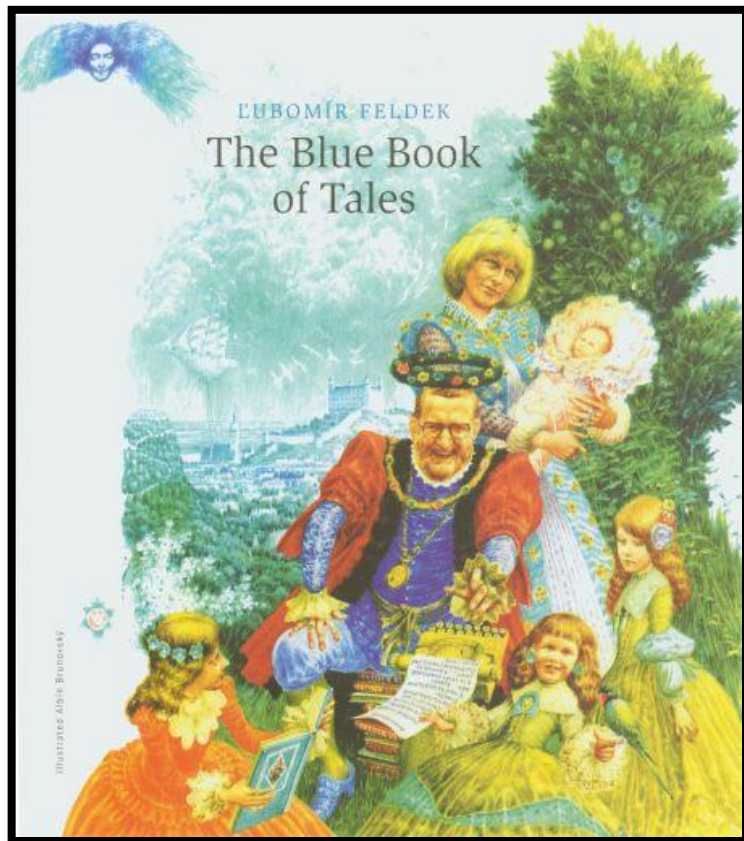

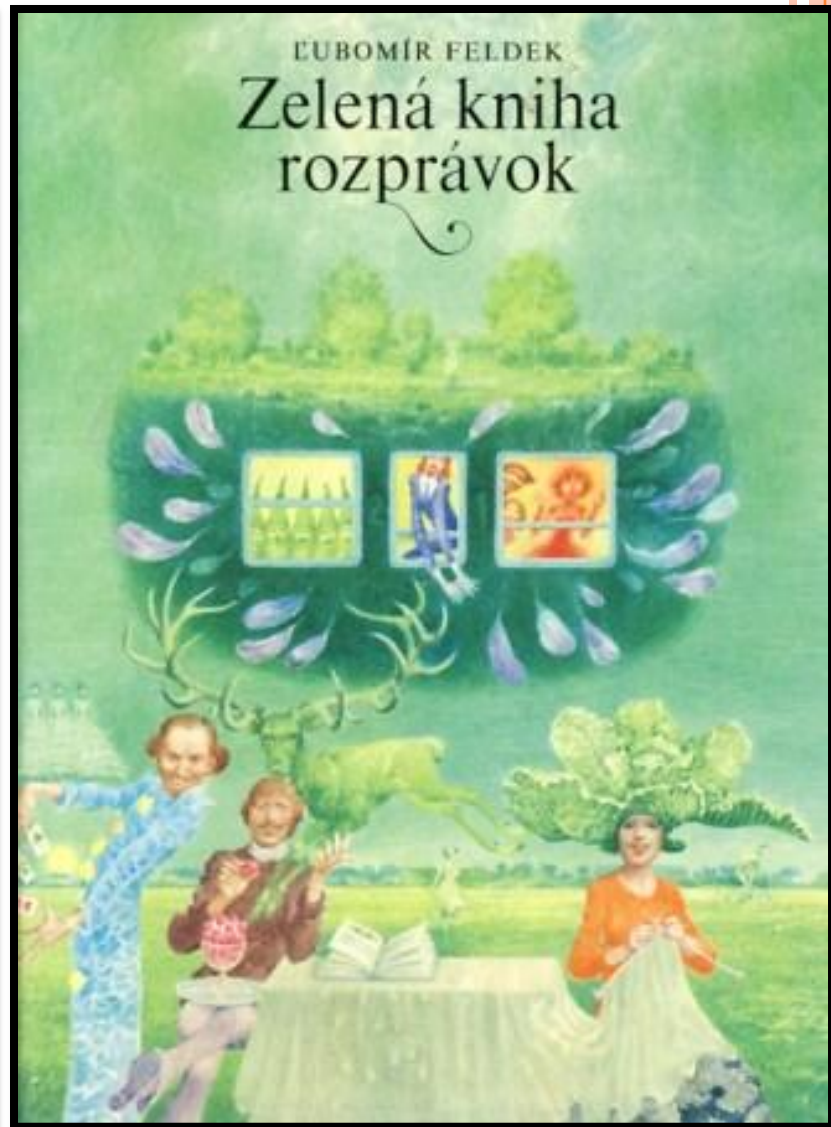


- He was born at Christmas in 1935 in Zohor (Czechoslovakia).
