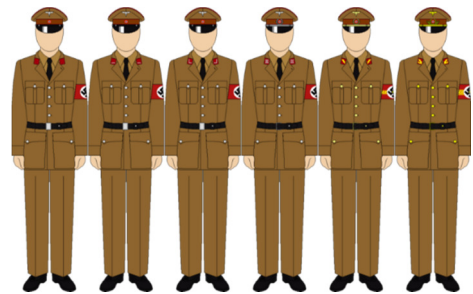

## **violations of human rights in Germany**

### **Violations of human right in the Past:**

In February 1933, one month after Hitler's take over, the basic rights were suspended by an emergency decree. In March he also suspended the whole state of law and the democracy "in a legal way". That was the beginning of the national socialist sovereignty. Between 1933 and 1945 there were a lot of cruel violations of human rights in whole Europe.



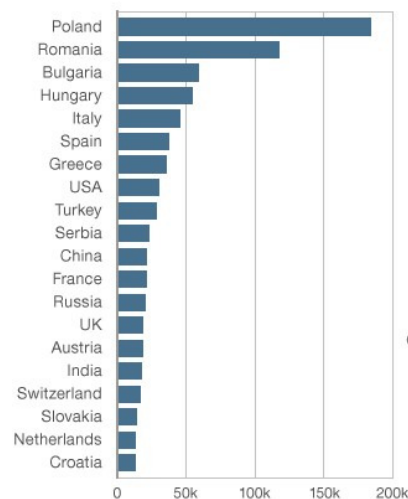
### **A few examples of violations of human rights today:**
